4. NEWS FROM FSU – WHAT'S COOKING

- The FSU Alumni Association has advised us that in an effort to provide better service and communication tools for the FSU alumni, the Association is converting to a new

constituent management system as part of their joint effort among all FSU Direct Support Organizations. The current contract with Harris Connect expired on Wednesday, May 13, 2008 resulting in the closure of the then-existing online community. They are in the process of converting the system to Blackbaud, which will provide an enhanced package of tools and services, including a new online community, web hosting and email messaging capabilities. The conversion is expected to have been completed by June 1, 2008. FSU student, Amanda Woods, 19, of Jacksonville, Florida, a soon-to-be sophomore political science major, took top honors, winning a \$10,000 prize for her entry in a contest sponsored by the Presidential Forum on Renewable Energy. The American Academy of Family Physicians presented its Top 10 Awards to FSU during the Society of Teachers of Family medicine annual conference in Baltimore, Md.
- FSU to Share \$7 Million Grant to study Autism in Toddlers. With a \$7 million grant from the National Institutes of Mental Health, FSU and University of Michigan researchers aim to find out how effective early intervention is for children diagnosed with ASD by the time they are 18 months old. The study is one of the largest of its kind and one of the first to explore intervention in children that young.
