- **Florida State Moves Up in Rankings**  
FSU is among the top 50 public universities, with some of the best undergraduate business programs in the nation, according to U.S. News and World Report's 2010 edition of "American's Best Colleges." FSU ranked 50<sup>th</sup> last year is now ranked 48<sup>th</sup>.



- **FSU Law, Medical Schools Ranked in Top 10 for Hispanic Students**  
FSU's colleges of law and medicine are among the Top 10 best in the nation for Hispanics, according to Hispanic Business magazine. The College of Law was ranked 3<sup>rd</sup> among the nation's law schools, while the College of Medicine was ranked 7<sup>th</sup> among medical schools.

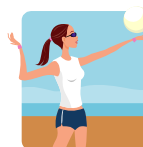

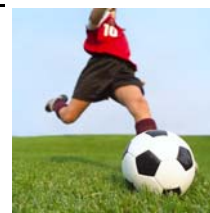
